

YWCA IS ON A MISSION



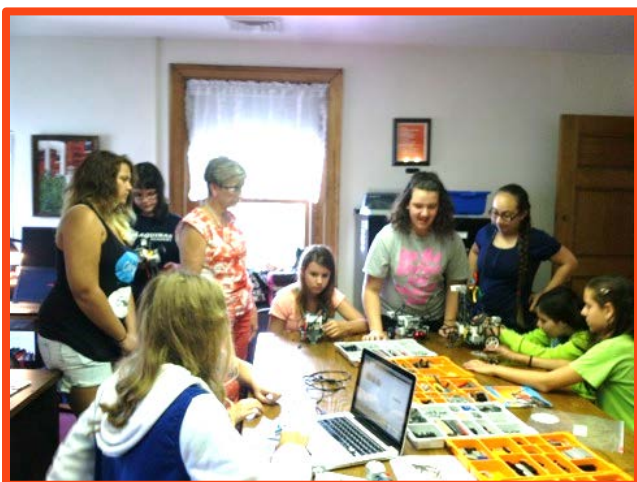
Dear Friend of the YWCA Westmoreland County,


